

Wild Oxfordshire

LONG GRASS - WILDFLOWERS

Mow outer areas of field in spring and autumn only:
Monitor with a view to plant wildflower plugs if diversity is lacking.
Increase in biodiversity, beneficial to all wildlife.

HEDGEROW

Plant native hedgerow trees in gaps along open boundary to railway:
Hawthorn, Purging buckthorn, Field maple, holly, Crab apple, Guelder rose, Elder, Honeysuckle, Dog rose, Field rose.
Increase in biodiversity, beneficial to all wildlife. Holly will provide all the year round screening



MOWN GRASS AREA

Sow with lotus, clover and prunella to increase biodiversity and attract bees

LONG GRASS

OAK & SMALL LEAVED LIME TREES

Trees planted to allow full mature growth and sub-divides area creating more structure

LONG GRASS

LEGO BRICKS

Long term plan is to remove lego bricks when vegetation has matured

BEE FRIENDLY HEDGES

Plant low flowering shrubs to attract bees and other pollinators, Rosa rugosa, Berberis darwinii. At the same time this will prevent vehicles entering the site.

TREES

Plant trees to encourage bees using:
Hawthorn, Whitebeam, Cherry, Rowan or crab apple.
Increase in biodiversity, beneficial to all wildlife.
